BACK THE BLUE BBQ COOK-OFF RULES

- Set up will begin at 7:00AM on Saturday, October 8, 2022, in front of the Jimmy Burke Activity Center located at 500 13th St. Deer Park, Texas. Teams can move in on Friday, October 7, 2022 with prior consent of the BBQ Committee.
- Spots will be clearly marked and each team will be assigned a spot. Please keep your team and area confined to your assigned spot.
- Each team must have their own BBQ pit. Any pit in question will be approved or disqualified by the Cook-Off committee chairperson.
- Turn in times will be posted at the event. Turn ins will be accepted up to five (5) minutes past the posted turn in time. Entries that are brought to the turn in area after the five minute window has closed will not be judged.
- All food must be cooked with a charcoal, wood, or on a propane cooker. No electric BBQ pits will be allowed.
- All meats must be raw when your team arrives and checks in. You may marinate after check in.
- Nothing other than the entry is allowed in the turn in container.
- Containers for entries will be supplied by the Cook-Off committee at the Cooks Meeting.
- Markings on or in the containers are grounds for immediate disqualification.

- No garnishments of any kind are allowed on or in the container.
- Each entry must have enough food for 6 judges.
- Turn in times are as follows:

Chicken @ 11AM Ribs @ 1PM Brisket @ 3PM

- Please clean up your area. Do not leave any coals present in your spot, whether they are completely cooled or not. There should be no trash on the ground when you leave your spot. Trash boxes and can liners will be provided for each spot.
- Entry forms are due October 1, 2021 and all fees should be paid by this date.
- Back The Blue reserves the right to make changes to the rules at anytime.

Back The Blue COOK OFF RULES For Rookie Chili Cook-Off

- Rookie Chili Cook-Off teams may consist of between one (1) and four (4) members.
- All chili must be cooked onsite.
- All Rookie Chili cook-off teams associated with a Back The Blue team must be able to be contained in the spot belonging the team.
- Rookie Chili Cook-Off teams entering by themselves (not associated with a Back The Blue Team) will be given a 10 x 10 spot in which it cook.
- All Rookie Chili-Off entries will be judged using a double-blind system.
- Judging will be at 2PM at the cook team spot.
- Small cups and spoons will be provided for judging.
